Regulations.

Axbridge Town Council owns two car parks – Axbridge Town Car Park (long stay) and Moorland Street Car Park (short stay). The car parks are intended for the temporary parking of vehicles. They are **free** to park in but regulations apply.

The key regulations are set out below. A full set of the regulations is available from the Town Clerk.

Appendix 1.

Welcome to Axbridge Town Car Park Free 48 hours parking

- No return within 2 hours
- Restrictions do not apply at weekends and public holidays

Furthermore:

- All vehicles are parked at the owners own risk
- No vehicles over 3.5 tonnes, lorries, caravans and trailers
- All vehicles must be taxed and insured.
- Parking permitted within the marked bays only.
- Blue Badges must be displayed when parking in the disabled bay.
- Please note that still photographs may be used for the enforcement of regulations.

This car park is regularly patrolled and a Penalty Notice may be served for any of the following:

Parking longer than permitted Parking outside a marked bay Being the wrong class of vehicle Unauthorised parking in disabled bay

Welcome to Axbridge Moorland Street Short Stay Car Park Free 2 hours parking

- No return within 2 hours
- The time restrictions applies from 8.00am 8.00pm
- These restrictions apply every day including weekends and bank holidays
- All vehicles are parked at the owners own risk
- No vehicles over 3.5 tonnes, lorries, caravans and trailers
- All vehicles must be taxed and insured.
- Parking permitted within the marked bays only.
- Blue Badges must be displayed when parking in the disabled bay.
- Please note that still photographs may be used for the enforcement of regulations.

This car park is regularly patrolled and a Penalty Notice may be served for any of the following:

- Parking longer than permitted
- Parking outside a marked bay
- Being the wrong class of vehicle
- Unauthorised parking in disabled bay
